Primary 2 Learning Outcomes for Semester 1

English Language

Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listen attentively and identify relevant information
Speaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Speak clearly to express their thoughts, feelings and ideas• Build on others' ideas in the conversations or discussions respectfully
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read multi-syllabic words accurately
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Apply basic spelling strategies using knowledge about phonic elements and spelling rules

Mother Tongue Languages

Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listen attentively to short, simple spoken content related to daily life, identify the main idea and some details
Speaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Speak with correct pronunciation using vocabulary and sentence structures from Primary 2 texts
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognise characters (Chinese Language) / words (Malay Language) / letters and words (Tamil Language) taught in Primary 2• Read aloud Primary 2 texts with accuracy and fluency• Understand Primary 2 texts and are able to identify details with some guidance

Mathematics

- Understand numbers up to thousand
- Solve mathematical problems involving addition and subtraction
- Multiply and divide numbers within multiplication tables

Social Studies

- Identify at least one custom and tradition practised by an ethnic group in Singapore
- Select relevant information to meet the objectives of a task, with teacher guidance
- Work together with other group members towards a common goal, with teacher guidance
- Show respectful and acceptable behaviour towards people of different ethnic and religious groups
- State ways to contribute at home, in class, in school and in the neighbourhood

Art

- Draw to express curiosity, ideas and things that relate to personal interests and experiences
- Explore and use visual qualities, materials, and artistic processes to share personal interests, imagination and curiosity in their art making
- Collect artifacts / learning evidence for portfolio based on given criteria
- Share and talk about their artworks using appropriate art vocabulary

Music

- Create rhythmic ostinato of at least 2 bars to accompany a melodic piece
- Create a melodic phrase of at least 2 bars to accompany a melodic piece
- Sing with accuracy and expression
- Play rhythmic and melodic patterns on pitched and non-pitched instruments expressively with accurate rhythm and pitch

- Demonstrate a range of motor skills in catching, dribbling, and striking a variety of objects
- Move to landmarks in school safely and confidently and apply knowledge about weather conditions and their effects on oneself
- Acquire a range of safety practices while playing, using the road, and in public places
