# 2.3 Learning for Life Programme (LLP)

Our LLP nurtures students' leadership competencies and civic responsibility through meaningful community engagement. This term, our Primary 4 students will participate in Values-in-Action learning experiences by connecting with seniors at Active Ageing Centres in our neighbourhood. Through scheduled visits, students will interact with and learn from elderly residents, fostering intergenerational bonds whilst developing empathy and communication skills. These experiences allow our students to put school values into practice and understand the importance of contributing to our community.

# 2.4 Applied Learning Programme (ALP)

Our ALP empowers Primary 4 and 5 students to tackle real-world sustainability challenges by applying knowledge across different subjects. Primary 4 students will explore food sustainability issues, whilst the Primary 5 students will focus on energy conservation. Working collaboratively, students will develop innovative solutions to these environmental challenges. The programme includes learning journeys that provide practical insights and inspire creative problem-solving approaches. Through this hands-on experience, we aim to nurture environmentally conscious citizens who can think critically and contribute meaningfully to a sustainable future.

## 2.5 Internationalisation Programme

Our Internationalisation Programme cultivates cross-cultural literacy, enabling students to understand and appreciate diverse perspectives. This term, selected Primary 5 students will host a group of Hong Kong students in April, whilst another group will

embark on an overseas learning journey to Hong Kong in May. These valuable experiences will allow our students to forge meaningful friendships, develop cultural sensitivity, and gain a broader global perspective through interactions with their peers from other countries.

## **3 PARTNERSHIP WITH PARENTS**

### 3.1 Breakfast with School Management

Our termly Breakfast with School Management, organised by our Parent Support Group (PSG) is a platform for parents to network and engage in meaningful discussions with the school management about educational or school matters.
